

## UNM Department of Ob/Gyn: Abortion Opt Out Policy and Process

The Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) requires that all obstetrics and gynecology residency programs provide training in comprehensive women's reproductive health care, including opt-out abortion training, in which training is routinely integrated into residency but residents with religious or moral objections can opt out of participation.

Benefits of training on your educational experience

- More experience with understanding the problem of unplanned pregnancy and its determinants
- More experience with first trimester ultrasound
- Greater comfort with cervical dilation
- More experience with D&C
- More experience with laminaria placement
- More training with Implanon/Nexplanon and IUD training (immediate insertion)
- More training in POC evaluation (helpful for miscarriage patients)
- More training in 2nd trimester termination for maternal/fetal indications
