- *Some women bleed more than a period

If YOU ARE **SOAKING** more than

2 MAXIPADS per hour **FOR MORE THAN**

2 HOURS in a row

If YOU HAVE **SEVERE CRAMPS** -AND-**PAIN PILLS** do not help

- *Nausea

- *Vomiting
- *Diarrhea
- *Temperature Higher than 100.4

If you are feeling worried and think you need to go to the Emergency Room (ER)

FEVER -AND-**CHILLS** are NORMAL On the day you take **MISOPROSTOL**

BUT IF YOU STILL HAVE FEVER OR **CHILLS** 24 HOURS after taking **MISOPROSTOL CALL US**

You can contact the on-call provider at 505-560-8899. This is a digital pager. When you hear the beep, put in a phone number (with area code) where you can be reached, followed by the # sign. If you do not get a call back within 15 minutes, try again. Or you may also call **505-272-2111**. This is the University Hospital's main operator. Tell them you would like to speak to the GYN Resident on-call. The operator will then connect your call.
